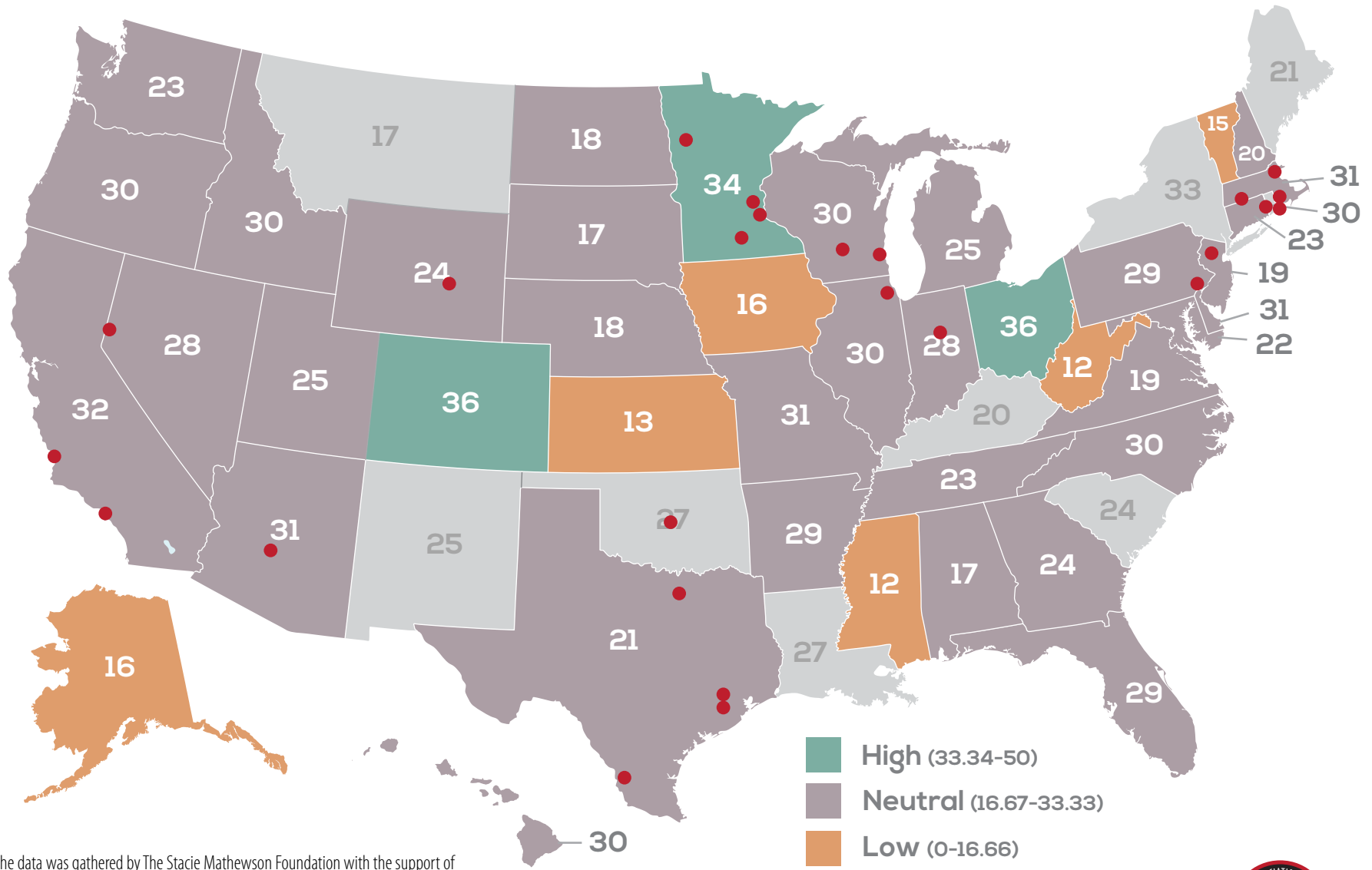


# Recovery School Favorability Report

A State-by-State Look at the Favorability for Starting and Sustaining Recovery Schools



The data was gathered by The Stacie Mathewson Foundation with the support of sr4 Partners as part of the 2013 Market Study for Recovery High Schools.

Scores were assigned based on 25 indicators identified during the Market Study. For each indicator a score of 2=High, a score of 1=Neutral and a score of 0=Low resulting in a total possible score of 50.
